2017 Fall Value Chain Survey Results Are In: California a Concern

Once again, the Survey revealed concerns with de-selection attempts at the state-level, particularly in California. Their continued focus is adding chemicals to the "Prop 65" red-list, as well as efforts to move product-specific industries away from certain "chemicals of concern."

As was pointed out multiple times in the survey's "open comment" section, "California Prop 65 would like to eliminate PVC and we need to be mindful that other states often follow California." As a sidebar, this comment is backed-up by the content of the new September 2017 State of California "Fact Sheet" on phthalates. The fact sheet takes liberties with science and risk assessment, with a highlighted recommendation to, "Avoid plastics known

as polyvinyl chloride (PVC) or vinyl (with recycle code 3)." The CA Fact Sheet can be seen here:

On a very positive note, 66% of respondents indicated that their vinyl product sales were growing. FVA-members also expressed satisfaction and support of FVA advocacy efforts to defend PVC at the state and federal levels, and FVA's continued highlighting of key vinyl applications in medical, flooring, wire and cable and other markets.

ADVOCACY IN ACTION

FVA Comments to State of California on Candidate Chemicals Related to Vinyl Flooring

FVA filed comments on November 6th to California's Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC). In its comments, FVA stated that any chemical and priority product chosen to be regulated by this program must meet both of the following criteria:

- 1) there must be potential public and/or aquatic, avian, or terrestrial animal or plant organism exposure to the Candidate Chemical(s) in the product;
- 2) there must be the potential for one or more exposures to contribute to or cause significant or widespread adverse impacts.

FVA's conclusion is that exposure to ortho-phthalates in vinyl flooring does not cause significant or widespread adverse impacts.

CPSC Issues Rule on Phthalates in Toys

After nearly a decade of proceedings, the Consumer Products Safety Commission (CPSC) voted 3 to 2 on October 18, 2017 to issue a final rule prohibiting children's toys and child care articles containing more than 0.1 percent of certain phthalate chemicals. The rule will take effect 180 days after publication in the Federal Register. The final rule removes the interim prohibition regarding DNOP and DIDP. CPSC has determined that these phthalates do not cause adverse effects on male reproductive development, and other risks attendant to their use are low. Other phthalates are permanently banned. - and, a continued effort to offer up positive messaging around the medical, building products, wire and cable, automotive products and other essentials fabricated with flexible vinyl.
